
A Work of God

The Way Home







The Way Home is a transformational discipleship ministry for men that are recovering from alcohol and drug addictions.

The ministry serves men from any area and walk of life. The only requirement is their commitment to live in a transformational way according to scripture in Romans 12:2

"Do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." (Romans 12:2a)





The Way Home located in Washington County provides the men access to churches, education, and job opportunities. The home houses up to 6 men in a 6 to 12 month program.

The Way Home is not a half way house or sober living home. Instead God has shown us to differentiate the ministry as place of discipleship.

- Half way houses are characterized by poor support for the men, criminal activity, and overcrowding.
- The Way Home is a ministry of intentional discipleship according to the commission of Jesus to make disciples (Matthew 28:20).
- The program provides men the help to begin leading a transformational life that starts with salvation and continues with sanctification. They are shown a new way of living.
- This is achieved through one on one discipleship of the men by volunteers from local churches.
- The program for the residents includes job training, employment services, and financial counseling.

A Ministry of the Body

The body being the local church of like minded believers that accepts the inerrant authority of scripture and seeks to live obediently in relationship with God under His authority to reach the lost with the "Good News" of salvation in Christ.

The Way Home is ministry of this body to show the men a **new home**, a **new life**, and a **new family**.

The ministry focuses on achieving this by:

- Offering a platform for the local church to minister to men in recovery.
- The church becoming the new family for these men by welcoming them into their fellowship.
- Mentoring and discipleship of the men at The Way Home showing them a new way to live.
- Helping the men to build a new life with the abilities and skills to replace addictions.
- Being the love of God that will enable them to deal with the issues of life
- Helping the men learn how to handle mistakes and setbacks while continuing their commitment to living an growing in Christ.



This Ministry Needs The Body

- Churches that will invite these men to become part of the family of God.
- Churches that will sponsor the ministry providing support spiritually and financially.
- Bed sponsors to support a bed for 30 or 60 days to give the men a chance to gain employment.
- Volunteers to work and disciple the men.
